In this live webcast with Matt Kloskowski, you'll learn some great techniques for editing your photos in Lightroom and when to jump over to Photoshop to help out. 3. You can enter the webcast room about 15 to 20 minutes before the webcast starts.
4. There will be an area for Q&A once you log in to the live webcast on the day of the webinar.
